- Established in 2023, UMOJI is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit community supporting adults transitioning from incarceration through mentorship, housing, and holistic programs.
- Registered under the Oregon Department of Justice Charitable Trust (Registration Number: 67294).

- To reintegrate adults released from incarceration into society through support programs, mentorship, and community building.


